

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-03

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE AUCTIONING OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Malvern currently has personal property which is of no further use to the City and is depreciating in value, and

WHEREAS, the City of Malvern is desirous to auction the personal property to the highest bidder.

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MALVERN CITY COUNCIL:

Section 4. It is necessary that this ordinance shall become effective immediately in order to provide of the prompt sale of said personal property to defer any future depreciation of value, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance, being necessary for the immediate protection of the public peace, health, and safety, shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
